

A MIRACLE FULL OF MESSAGES

JOHN 2:1-11

Considering who Jesus was, God manifested in flesh, one would have thought that when the time came for Him to begin His earthly ministry, He would have began it with a little more fanfare than He did.

Jesus began His public ministry without calling a press conference. There were no TV cameras, no radio stations and no newspaper reporters present.

The Bible doesn't tell us who it was that was getting married because that really wasn't what was important. The significance of what was taking place was that Jesus was there. The couple getting married were probably just common people, and that lets us know that Jesus cared about ordinary people just like you and me. Every person matters to God!

At the wedding, they ran out of wine. Mary said to the servants concerning Jesus, "Whatever He tells you to do, do it."

That is still good advice for each of us today. If Jesus tells you to do something, just do it!

Message number two. If you want to be an insider spiritually, become a servant. The servants who obeyed what Jesus told them to do, knew things that the others didn't know.

Message number three. God is in the transformation business. What the servants put into the pots was water but when it came time to draw it out, it was wine. A transformation had taken place.

Message number four. God often saves the best till last. It doesn't matter what your life has been like up to this moment, we serve a God who can turn things around and make them better than they have ever been before.

Our God is able to give beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning and the garment of praise in place of a spirit of heaviness.
